<p>Performance Outcomes</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Approach/scope to meet identified project goals and improve the stated issues/ deficiencies – state of good repair; multimodal/transportation choice; climate adaptation and resiliency; freight movement; and/or safety and security • Project benefits to the transportation network and impacted communities 	35 pts
<p>Community and Partner Engagement</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Community involvement in the development and design of the project • Partnerships involved in the project development and implementation 	15 pts
<p>Project Delivery and Readiness</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Funding commitment • Cost effectiveness • Project leverage for other federal and state funding program 	20 pts
