

Mobility Hub Framework

Types, Services, and Amenities

Major Transit-Focused Hub

- Largest in scale.
- Focused on public transit and supported by other multimodal choices for first and last-mile connectivity.
- Mostly located in regional and local destinations such as employment centers, major educational institutions, and areas with a diversity of activities.

Local Connector Hub

- Smaller in scale than the major transit-focused hub.
- Located in medium to high-density residential or mixed-use districts.
- Situated along main transit routes, supported by multimodal mobility options to connect riders to essential services and/or to major transit-focused hubs.

Commuter Hub

- Smaller in scale than the major transit-focused hub and local connector hub.
- Addresses daily trip needs by providing multimodal choices, connecting major travel routes and destinations.
- Integrate park-and-ride and carpool/rideshare services.
- Located near employment centers, retail, etc.

Neighborhood Hub

- Smaller than the local connector and commuter hubs.
- Primarily focused on active transportation and bike-ped scooter facilities as a first and last-mile connection to larger mobility hubs and local destinations.
- Can include rideshare, taxi pick-up/drop-off zones, or carshare options.

Seasonal Hub

- Caters to seasonal needs in high-visitation areas during specific times of the year, such as state fairs, stadiums, convention centers, museums, A's Games, apple picking season, etc.
- It can be a temporary installation of any mobility hub type.
