RESOLUTION NO. 100 – 2023

APPROVING THE COUNTY OF SUTTER'S TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT ACT CLAIM FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,005,715

WHEREAS, the County of Sutter has submitted a claim for Fiscal Year (FY) 2023-2024 Local Transportation Funds (LTF) for \$1,005,715 and;

WHEREAS, the County is contributing \$230,015 of the \$1,235,730 total allocations to Yuba-Sutter Transit Authority (YSTA) for transit services. Resolution No. 9-23 joint agreement allows YSTA to directly claim LTF. The claim is submitted under the provisions of the Transportation Development Act for the amounts and purposes as follows:
