### Draft Action Minutes

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The SACOG Board of Directors met in person on November 14, 2024, at 9:00 at SACOG, 1415 L Street, Suite 300, Sacramento, CA consistent with California Government Code Section 54953.

5. 2025 Blueprint: Draft Final Transportation Project List and Performance

Clint Holtzen, SACOG staff, presented the report. It was moved, seconded (Desmond/Kozlowski) and passed by unanimous vote that the board:

**ADOPT THE DRAFT FINAL TRANSPORTATION PROJECT LIST, WITH THE INCORPORATION OF RECLASSIFYING THE CALTRANS PROJECTS AS NON-SPONSORED, TO BE COMBINED WITH THE ADOPTED LAND USE ASSUMPTIONS; THUS, FORMING THE FINAL PREFERRED SCENARIO FOR THE 2025 METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION PLAN/SUSTAINABLE COMMUNITIES STRATEGY, KNOWN AS THE 2025 BLUEPRINT.**

5. Michael Garabedien, Placer County Tomorrow, regarding opposition to the project list and concerns about Placer County's traffic congestion.
