

**TRANSIT NEEDS PUBLIC HEARING IN  
YUBA COUNTY AND SUTTER COUNTY, INCLUDING THE  
CITIES OF MARYSVILLE AND YUBA CITY  
MINUTES**

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**October 24, 2022 – 1:00 P.M.**

**Hearing - Yuba County Government Center – Marysville Room**

The hearing was conducted by Karm Bains, representing the SACOG Board of Directors, with Barbara VaughanBechtold SACOG staff, and Matt Mauk and Adam Hansen, of Yuba-Sutter Transit, and Lindsey Wells and Jennique Lee, of FREED representing the Joint Yuba-Sutter Social Service Transportation Advisory Council.

Director Bains and Ms. VaughanBechtold provided an overview of SACOG and the unmet transit needs hearing process. Mr. Mauk reviewed Yuba-Sutter Transit services, including information on their paratransit services. No members of the public attended the Unmet Transit Needs hearing; four (4) items of correspondence were received.

Currently there are limited Yuba-Sutter commuter bus lines. My office is moving to the Riverside Boulevard Office Complex (RBOC) at 651 Bannon Street in Sacramento and this move will require me to catch a green line light rail as well. This will give me 2 options for my working day. Both of which are an 8-hour working day, but I will be away from home for over 12 hours. In comparison to driving I would be away from home for 9.5 hours. Due to the limited parking at RBOC, I will be in need of the public transportation from Yuba City to RBOC.
