APPROVING YUBA COUNTY’S TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT ACT CLAIM FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,010,330

WHEREAS, Yuba County has submitted a claim for Fiscal Year 2023-2024 Local Transportation Funds (LTF) for \$1,010,330 under the provisions of the Transportation Development Act for the amounts and purposes as follows:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board hereby approves the request for FY 2023-2024 Local Transportation Funds for \$1,010,330 and authorizes the forwarding of funds to Yuba County in proportion to funds received from the State.
