Local Need <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Priority for the agency (<i>for the set aside program, this should also demonstrate a regional priority, such as inclusion on the prioritization list, received previous regional support for grant funding, or is included in a regional document other than the MTP/SCS</i>)• Need of project and project goals• Communities impacted, including underrepresented communities• Alignment with funding program goals (<i>for the set aside program, this should demonstrate partnerships and a strong regional component</i>)	30 pts
Performance Outcomes <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Approach/scope to meet identified project goals and improve the stated issues/ deficiencies – state of good repair; multimodal/transportation choice; climate adaptation and resiliency; freight movement; and/or safety and security• Project benefits to the transportation network and impacted communities	35 pts
Community and Partner Engagement <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Community involvement in the development and design of the project• Partnerships involved in the project development and implementation	15 pts
Project Delivery and Readiness <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Funding commitment• Cost effectiveness• Project leverage for other federal and state funding program	20 pts
