APPROVING FTA SECTION 5310 ENHANCED MOBILITY FOR SENIORS AND INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES FUNDING PROGRAMMING FOR: ASIAN COMMUNITY CENTER OF SACRAMENTO VALLEY, INC. DBA ACC SENIOR SERVICES, CITY OF ROSEVILLE (TRANSIT), PRIDE INDUSTRIES TRANSIT, SACRAMENTO COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF CHILD, FAMILY, AND ADULT SERVICES (SENIOR VOLUNTEER SERVICES), UNITED CEREBRAL PALSY ASSOCIATION OF GREATER SACRAMENTO, INC., AND SHORES OF HOPE

WHEREAS, the Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG) is the Metropolitan Planning Organization and the Regional Transportation Planning Agency responsible for transportation planning in the Sacramento region; and

WHEREAS, SACOG is responsible for preparing and adopting the Metropolitan Transportation Plan/Sustainable Communities Strategy and the Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, SACOG is responsible for scoring and recommending Federal Transit Administration (FTA) 5310 Enhanced Mobility for Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities “Traditional” and “Expanded” projects in the SACOG Regional Transportation Planning Agency area and those projects in the Sacramento Urbanized Area; and

WHEREAS, SACOG has reviewed and scored FTA Section 5310 Grant Program Fiscal Year 2019/20 and recommends the Asian Community Center of Sacramento Valley, Inc. DBA ACC Senior Services, City of Roseville (Transit), Pride Industries Transit, Sacramento County Department of Child, Family, and Adult Services (Senior Volunteer Services), United Cerebral Palsy Association of Greater Sacramento, Inc., and Shores of Hope projects.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that SACOG certifies that:

1. The recommended projects are consistent with SACOG’s adopted Metropolitan Transportation Plan/Sustainable Communities Strategy (MTP/SCS).
2. The recommended projects are included in the SACOG Public Transit and Human Services Transportation Coordinated Plan as required by the Federal Transit Administration (FTA).

3. If awarded, the recommended projects will be programmed in the Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Program (MTIP).
