## APPROVING THE COUNTY OF YUBA'S TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT ACT CLAIM FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$975,783

WHEREAS, the County of Yuba has submitted a claim for Fiscal Year (FY) 2021-2022 Local Transportation Funds (LTF) for \$975,783 under the provisions of the Transportation Development Act for the amounts and purposes as follows:

WHEREAS, Yuba County has provided \$928,859 of \$1,904,642 total LTF allocation to Yuba-Sutter Transit Authority (YSTA) to provide public transit services in the Yuba-Sutter Transit Area as approved in the YSTA Board Resolution No.6-21: and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that** the Board hereby approves the request for FY 2021-2022 Local Transportation Funds for \$975,783 and authorizes the forwarding of funds to the County of Yuba in proportion to funds received from the State.
