RESOLUTION NO. 42 – 2022

AUTHORIZATION FOR THE EXECUTION OF THE THE LOW CARBON TRANSIT OPERATIONS PROGRAM (LCTOP) PROJECTS:

WHEREAS, SACOG is an eligible project sponsor and may receive state funding from the LCTOP now or sometime in the future for transit projects; and

WHEREAS, the statutes related to state-funded transit projects require a local or regional implementing agency to abide by various regulations; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 862 (2014) named the Department of Transportation (Department) as the administrative agency for the LCTOP; and

WHEREAS, the Department has developed guidelines for the purpose of administering and distributing LCTOP funds to eligible project sponsors (local agencies); and

WHEREAS, SACOG is a Contributing Sponsor to multiple lead agencies and also an eligible recipient of the LCTOP funds; and

WHEREAS, SACOG wishes to delegate authorization to execute these documents and any amendments to the SACOG's Executive Director; and

WHEREAS, SACOG wishes to implement the LCTOP projects listed below,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of SACOG that the fund recipient agrees to comply with all conditions and requirements set forth in the Certification and Assurances and the Authorized Agent documents and applicable statutes, regulations and guidelines for all LCTOP funded transit projects.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Executive Director be authorized to execute all required documents of the LCTOP program and any Amendments thereto with the California Department of Transportation.
