Draft Action Minutes

The SACOG Board of Directors met remotely on June 16, 2022, at 9:30 a.m.

Call to Order: Chair Jennings called the meeting to order at 9:33 a.m.

Action:

13. Consideration of Action Related to Sacramento County Transportation Tax Initiative
James Corless, SACOG staff, and Kirk Trost, General Counsel, presented the report.

Director Schenirer made a motion to approve the framework of the agreement and delegate authority to the Executive Director to sign a final MOU among the parties consistent with the framework (Desmond seconded).

Director Burruss made a substitute motion (Spokely seconded), that the Executive Director, prior to executing the memorandum of understanding, would obtain the approval of the board chair, the three policy committee chairs, and representatives of each county. The motion failed (Bains, Desmond, Gore, Guerrero, Jennings, Kennedy, Kozlowski, Lozano, Middleton, Sander, Saragosa, Saylor, Schenirer, Stallard, Suen, and Thomas opposed).

Director Schenirer amended his motion (Desmond seconded) to approve the framework of the agreement and delegate authority to the Executive Director to sign the final MOU among the parties, consistent with the framework, and that the Executive Director and General Counsel will engage with the Board Chair and the chairs of the Board's three policy committees, who shall serve as an advisory group to the Executive Director and General Counsel, and that the Executive Director and General Counsel shall reach out to board members from the counties not represented on the advisory group as part of developing the final MOU. The motion passed by majority vote (Bains, Boomgaarden (for Harris) and Burruss opposed).
