APPROVING THE COUNTY OF YUBA’S TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT ACT CLAIM FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,247,967

WHEREAS, the County of Yuba has submitted a claim for FY 2022-2023 Local Transportation Funds (LTF) for \$1,247,967 under the provisions of the Transportation Development Act for the amounts and purposes as follows:

WHEREAS, Yuba County has provided \$1,115,870 of \$2,292,922 total LTF allocation to Yuba-Sutter Transit Authority (YSTA) to provide public transit services in the Yuba-Sutter Transit Area as approved in the YSTA Board Resolution No.8-22: and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board hereby approves the request for FY 2022-2023 Local Transportation Funds for \$1,247,967 and authorizes the forwarding of funds to the County of Yuba in proportion to funds received from the State.
