

Committee Materials for SACOG's Revamped Regional Monitoring and Reporting program

At its June 29th meeting, the REI working group will hear an update on, and provide input to, SACOG's revamped data collection, monitoring and progress reporting process.

Program staff have put together 3 attachments to help support this committee conversation:

- **Attachment A. 2021 SACOG Regional Progress Report**

The first attachment is the prior iteration of the agency's Regional Progress Report, released in February of 2021. The progress report tracks how the region is trending on a wide array of regional economic, demographic, environmental, and transportation-related outcomes. To date SACOG has released the Regional Progress Report every few years as a static pdf, but is transitioning to a recurring, web-based interface.

- **Attachment B. Current Indicator Tables**

The two Current Indicator tables (B1 and B2) list out the indicators used in the prior Regional Progress Report. The first of these tables (B1) is a summary version, hopefully more easily organizing the numerous metrics into themes and key questions asked. The second table describes each of the nearly 50 indicators as well as relevant information such as source, years covered, and peer comparisons.

- **Attachment C. Scan of other Regional Data Collection/Monitoring Efforts**

In kicking off the revamped Monitoring and Reporting program, SACOG has reviewed similar efforts at our counterpart agencies in California and in a set of peer mid-sized regions throughout the country. Through this review we have tried to identify issues/themes others are tracking that we have not. Staff has compiled a matrix by topical areas as well as a drill down into the individual areas.
