### Civic Lab Year 1 Pilot Projects Update

#### 1. Issue:

This item provides an update on the first year of the Civic Lab program and discusses the 10 pilot projects developed by the Civic Lab Year 1 teams.

#### 2. Recommendation:

#### 3. Background/Analysis:

Civic Lab Year 1 brought together cross disciplinary teams to tackle challenging issues related to transportation and land use, and to pilot innovative solutions that can have local and regional impacts. Teams consisting of public agencies and private sector partners came together to test and innovate on planning, programs, and policy. Last year, SACOG budgeted \$1 million dollars to help fund and implement Civic Lab pilot projects.

Eight teams participated in the inaugural year of Civic Lab. Through monthly workshops, each team created a scope, schedule, and budget with their selected vendor to launch a pilot. Of the 10 pilot projects, eight have launched.

#### 4. Discussion/Analysis:

This item provides an update on the status of the 10 pilot projects developed by Civic Lab Year 1 teams. A detailed summary of projects can be found in Attachment A.

#### 5. Fiscal Impact/Grant Information:
